



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Your child's completed Registration Form and these Terms and Conditions of Participation (which may be amended by Coastal Cheer Co.). Terms and Conditions are the conditions upon which you agree to allow your child to participate in the Coastal Cheer Co. cheerleading program.

The Program is delivered in various formats depending on the specific format for which your child registers to participate. The Participant Benefits your child will receive may vary depending on the Program format, and there may be differences in session duration and season length, which will be outlined during registration.

The number of sessions and participant benefits for each program format will be specified in your registration.

### **Safeguarding Children and Young People**

Coastal Cheer Co. is committed to promoting and protecting the safety and well-being of children and young people involved in the Program. We have implemented policies and procedures for safeguarding children and young people, including a Code of Conduct and Reporting Procedure.

### **Application to Participate**

(a) For each child you are registering in the Program, you must:

- You must complete the online registration form
- Pay the fee to Coastal Cheer Co.
- Ensure your child agrees to abide by the cheerleading code of behaviour (find below)
- Understand and agree to comply with parents, guardians and spectators code of conduct
- Comply with any policies issued by Coastal Cheer Co. and all relevant laws, including those related to COVID-19 Vaccinations

(b) You warrant that each child you submit an application for:

- Will be within the appropriate age range for the program registered
- Does not have any known pre-existing medical or other conditions that would make participation unsafe without proper certification from a qualified medical practitioner

(c) Coastal Cheer Co. will process and accept registrations until all places in the specified program are filled. Should all positions be filled waitlist will be opened. When a spot becomes available automatic emails will be sent out in order from the first person registered on the list every 3 hours until the position is taken.

(d) Coastal Cheer Co. will not process incomplete, unclear, or fee-less applications.

(e) Understand all team communication is done via BAND, whether that be through mobile or desk app and understand it is the parents/guardians' responsibly to keep up to date.



## **Participant Benefits and Number of Sessions**

Upon acceptance of the registration and payment of the fee, the registered child will receive the relevant participant benefits for the program format they have registered for, as outlined in item

The number of sessions included in each Program format is specified as follows:

- (a) Each participant will receive one cheerleading bow and one keyring per season, should this be lost you may purchase a replacement through the online store.
- (b) Each participant will register for a full-term program as outlined in your online registration, any missed classes for any reason will not be refunded

*Additional sessions may be provided at the discretion of the Program coordinators.*

## **Limitation of Liability and Release Waiver**

(a) You acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with participation in the Program, and you agree not to hold Coastal Cheer Co. or its directors, employees, agents, and volunteers liable for any damage, loss, or injury suffered during participation.

(b) Coastal Cheer Co.'s liability (including that of its directors, employees, agents, and volunteers) is limited to refunding any amounts paid under these Terms and Conditions or providing or resupplying Program services as outlined herein.

(c) You acknowledge the Sports Injury Insurance benefits provided by Coastal Cheer Co. and understand that these benefits may not be comprehensive. It is recommended to explore personal insurance options to ensure appropriate coverage.

(d) You acknowledge the unquantifiable risk of transmission of viral illnesses, including COVID-19, associated with participation in the Program, and you accept these risks.

(e) Coastal Cheer Co. its agents, contractors any person representing have your full authority and is directed to consent to and to authorise any medical attention, treatment, surgery or administration of drugs by qualified and licensed medical personnel for our athletes/students, which they deem necessary.

## **Cancellation, Refunds, and Termination**

(a) The fee paid covers the session commitment and participant benefits as outlined above. No compensation will be provided for any sessions missed by the participant.

(b) Refunds will only be provided under specific circumstances, such as a child's medical condition preventing further participation or if the Program has not been delivered to the expected standard, as determined by Coastal Cheer Co. Refund inquiries should be directed to Coastal Cheer Co. via email.

(c) Coastal Cheer Co. is not liable for any loss or damage resulting from the cancellation, postponement, or changes to the Program.

(d) Coastal Cheer Co. will not replace lost, stolen, or damaged participant benefits.

(e) Coastal Cheer Co. reserves the right to terminate a child's participation in the Program if their behaviour jeopardizes the safety or enjoyment of other participants.

(f) Coastal Cheer Co. may, at its discretion, change aspects of the program, including dates, session times, durations, and locations.



## **Extreme Weather Policy**

In the event of extreme weather conditions, classes may be cancelled if there is no option of an undercover/inside facility. This will depend on individual locations; please see the registration page for that class for full details. Extreme weather would be considered raining or over 37.5 degrees Celsius. Messages regarding class changes will be sent out via the Band App.

## **Privacy**

(a) Personal information collected during registration will be used for processing applications and may be used for sending program-related information or offers. This information may be also used for research and evaluation purposes.

1. Manners will be remembered at all times, please and thank you go a long way!
2. Students must understand that the TEAM comes before the individual for reasons of safety and inclusivity
3. Coaches reserve the right to modify routines as needed, and students will be expected to support decisions that are deemed as best for the team.
4. We will only allow skills that have been mastered with proper technique to be competed. This is at the coaches' discretion.
5. Absolutely NO jewellery can be worn to practice
6. Coastal Cheer Co. strives to maintain positive vibe for all with an inclusive community, no gossip, pettiness, bullying or alienating will be tolerated whatsoever. These continued behaviours are grounds for dismissal from our program
7. Students must treat their coaches, guest instructors, volunteers and admin staff with the utmost respect. We promise to do the same for our students
8. Students must communicate with coaches. If you don't tell us you're injured, we may not know



9. Be aware of your actions inside and outside the gym, you are representing Coastal Cheer Co. and will be expected to be a positive role model at all times
